POOLS

We've once again increased the number of shorter tees and alternate baskets this year. Thanks to your feedback, we've created varied layouts that provide more fun for everyone — but they also come with a few challenges.

Please pay close attention to which pool you're assigned to, as your pool may start from different tees or even play to different baskets.

Always check the signage and follow the information provided in the caddy book to ensure you're throwing from the correct tee and targeting the right basket.

Tiebreakers

Ties for first place will be decided via sudden death using holes 1, 10, and 9. This sequence will be repeated until a winner is determined. Tees will be played according to the division-specific pool assignment.

803.2.A Relief from Obstacles


For any vegetation with thorns or spikes, as well as artificial elements (such as those from the archery course), we allow optional relief in line with PDGA Rule 803.2.A “Relief from Obstacles” directly backward along the line of play, up to 1 meter.

Additional examples: benches, fences, signs, tee signs, safety netting, other baskets, ground anchors, etc.

Out of Bounds (OB)

To reduce environmental impact (and to save ourselves some time), we will not stretch string between OB stakes. Instead, each card will receive an envelope with 15 meters of string. The OB line is defined by connecting the outer edges of the stakes.

Please return the string kits to the TD desk at the end of your round.

Toilets

Portable toilets will be available at hole 1 and at the junction of the paths to holes 5 and 11. You can also use the toilets at the swimming pool (lower level) and at the Schützenhaus.

Food

Pre-ordered meals can be enjoyed at the Schützenhaus between 10:00 and approx. 17:00 in a cozy atmosphere.

Drinks and snacks will be available from the Leinen Los team next to the TD office, supporting the ongoing maintenance of the course.

The HyzerCrew will also provide free fruit and cereal bars at the TD office.

Showers

If you'd like to boost your circulation, you can use the cold-water showers at the swimming pool free of charge.

Swimming Pool Closing Time

The swimming pool (and therefore the passage to the Schützenhaus) closes at 20:00 — except for the players party, of course.

Water Stations

At holes 1 and 11 you'll find canisters filled with drinking water. Please let us know if they need refilling.

First Aid

A first aid kit is located in the TD office.





SPOTING

Spotters!

Always watch out for hikers and cyclists on the paths! These are hiking trails in a tourist region, so when in doubt, always use a spotter.

In the caddy book you will find the following symbol — these holes require extra attention and involve significant risks for other people.



Attention!

There are several areas on the course where holes run close to one another or cross hiking trails. Only throw when no people are at risk, and only enter fairways after checking the airspace carefully.

Risk areas include:

- Basket hole 1 – tee pad hole 2
- Basket hole 2 – tee pads hole 3
- Path from hole 4 to hole 5 crosses hole 2
- Tee pad hole 5 – fairway hole 6
- Tee pad hole 8 – hilltop hides fairway
- Hole 9 – hiking trail on the left
- Hole 10 – hiking trail crossing and tee pad hole 9
- Hole 12 – tee pad hole 13 and steep slope (lost discs)
- Holes 14 to 16 – adjacent fairways
- Hole 17 – hiking trail crossing near basket
- Hole 18 long tee – hikers approaching from above



SCORING & PARKING

Scoring

Each player must record the scores for their card. Scoring will be done via the platform turniere.discgolf.de. In case of technical issues, paper scorecards will be available. Scoring duties may also be assigned to caddies.

Parking

Space in front of the tournament area is very limited. Please park tightly, just as you would in a big city. Keep emergency access routes clear!

Further down the road there is a small parking lot in front of the recycling center, be sure to respect the reserved spaces and leave them free.

Also further down the road is a gravel parking lot, which can again be used in part.

We highly recommend carpooling. As a backup, on Sundays and public holidays you may also park at the supermarkets up the street.

TIPS AND FAQ

Hole 1

If the disc rolls behind the net near the basket, the net must not be moved.

Hole 7 (Flo-Ace)

If you go OB on the right side, you may retreat without penalty. Mark your lie 1 m from the last point inbounds, then move backward along the line of play toward the basket. Applies to every throw marked OB.

Holes 10 (Island) & 18 – Optional Drop Zone

On both holes you may choose, after a throw that lands OB, to continue from the drop zone, or if possible, from the last point where the disc crossed inbounds, or to rethrow. This applies to all throws, not just tee shots.

Hole 14 (Dino) – Hazard Rule 806.05

For a penalty to apply, the disc must be completely surrounded by hazard. Only one penalty can be assessed (the highest or first, Rule 801.02.I). Penalties do not stack. For example, if you go OB and your lie is in the hazard, only one penalty stroke applies. You may stand in the hazard. If your lie is on the edge, you are NOT allowed to take an extra meter. The disc must not be moved.

Use the rule search function in the UDisc or PDGA scoring app. There you can search for rules by keyword to get clarification.

Alternatively, you can also ask an AI, for example: “PDGA rule disc OB”. Since the rules are structured logically, it works quite well and may provide the information in a more digestible way. However, the official PDGA rules are always decisive.



TIPS AND FAQ

Mandos

The disc must never touch or break through the imaginary wall of air defined by the mando. This also applies if it rolls back after having already passed the mando, or if it crosses the line for just a split second. (PDGA 804.01)

OB

New this year: If a disc clearly flies into OB, it no longer counts as “Lost.” That means no 3 minutes of searching and no one is obliged to look for it!

If another card is already waiting on the tee behind you, you are required to continue play promptly. (PDGA 805.03.G)

Forest

There is still a lot of leaf cover and grass on the ground. Better to spot once too often than to lose a disc.

OB OVERVIEW



For easier orientation, we have added the internal hole names in parentheses.

Hole 1

Left: warm-up area, right: field and return path from hole 18.

Hole 2 (Jail)

Right: blackthorn bushes and fairway hole 4, left: blackthorn bushes. Left-side mando.

Hole 3 (Reversed)

No OB.

Hole 4 (Clover)

OB surrounding.

Hole 5 (Two Fairways)

Left: fairways 6 & 7, right: blackthorn bushes after mando and around the basket. Left-side mando.

Hole 6 (Par 3/Par 4)

Right: forest, left: fairway hole 5 and the area before it.

Hole 7 (FloAce)

Left: fairway hole 5, right: forest.

Hole 8 (Pasture)

OB surrounding along forest edge, tighter OB left of the basket.

Hole 9 (Gorge)

Left: blackthorn bushes and hiking trail, right and long: steep slope.

Hole 10 (Island)

Surrounded by vegetation boundary. Optional drop zone for OB.

Hole 11 (Michl)

Left: trees, right: field, basket surrounded by forest edge.

Hole 12 (Deer Meadow)

Left: steep slope.

Hole 13 (Lynx Hunt)

Left: steep slope.

Hole 14 (Dino)

Left: hazard between hunting stand and blackthorn bushes. OB left starting from fairway 15, long: blackthorn bushes and fairway 16.

Hole 15 (Spruce)

Left: trees, right: fairway hole 16, basket surrounded.

Hole 16 (Triple Mando)

Left: forest, after mando vegetation and meadow, right: fairways 15 & 16 plus blackthorn bushes, basket surrounded.

Hole 17 (Gate)

No OB.

Hole 18

Left: blackthorn bushes, vegetation, field. Optional drop zone for OB.






